I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

II. STAFFING

Chief Goldstein stated that the department currently has the following vacancies: 2 dispatchers, 1 detective and 3 patrol officers. He did advise they were interviewing a patrol candidate tomorrow. They currently have 3 officers on a shift but due to short staffing sometimes there are only 2 officers on a shift. He advised that there are some part-time officers that are helping fill in as well. Councilor Webb asked if overtime was being used to fill the open shifts. Chief Goldstein said yes, it comes at a cost. He advised the profession isn't sought after anymore. Mayor Brown stated that the pay and class study should be helpful for recruitment.

III. OTHER BUSINESS

The committee discussed parking options for businesses downtown that have customers that may park longer than two hours.
