

## Press Release 19 September 2014

On September 18th, 2014 at approximately 1214 hours the Franklin Police arrested 42 year old Scott Tripp of Franklin on a warrant in the parking lot of the Franklin Fast Food Mart, 80 No. Main St.

According to police affidavits, a search of Tripp incident to arrest revealed he was in possession of nearly five hundred (500) Oxycodone pills, over a dozen Adderall pills, and over \$600.00 in cash. Both Oxycodone and Adderall are classified by the DEA as Schedule II controlled drugs which require a prescription to possess. The quantity of Oxycodone and Adderall seized from Tripp had an approximate street value of over \$15,000.00.

Tripp was charged with two (2) counts of Possession of a Controlled Drug and two (2) counts of Possession of a Controlled Drug with the Intent to Sell. Both are felony level offenses.

Tripp refused bail services and was remanded to the Merrimack County Department of Corrections pending arraignment at 6<sup>th</sup> Circuit - District Division – Franklin Court on 09/19/14.
