

PRESS RELEASE

On September 23, 2013, members of the Franklin Police Department were dispatched to the Franklin Woods apartment complex for a report of a domestic disturbance. When the first officer arrived his fully marked police cruiser was struck by a white Mitsubishi 3000 GT as it was driving out of the apartment complex. The Mitsubishi was operated by a male subject, Andrew Marchand, 26, of Hill, NH.

Marchand was arrested for Driving Under the Influence. After further investigation it was determined Marchand was involved in the initial domestic disturbance. Marchand was subsequently charged with Criminal Mischief, Simple Assault and Disorderly Conduct.



Marchand was released on \$3,000.00 Personal Recognizance and the condition he remain on good behavior. Marchand was also ordered to have no contact with the victim.

On September 27th 2013 the Franklin Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a white 1993 Mitsubishi 3000 on North Main Street. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Andrew Marchand. Officers learned the victim from Marchand's arrest on the 23rd was a passenger in his vehicle at the time of the stop. Marchand was subsequently arrested for Stalking and Default or Breach of Bail and remanded to the Merrimack County Department of Corrections in lieu of \$5,000.00 cash bail.
